In so far as possible, preferential, reserved seating will be given to donors of this year's program; other seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Reserved seats must be occupied 10 minutes before the performance.

- ★ Our celebratory season finale and anniversary reception starts at 6:30 pm on Saturday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, with tickets for \$25, which includes the reception and the evening performance.
